This 10 day tour will include a full seven days in Myanmar with visits to Yangon, the capital city of Myanmar, Bagan historical ruins, the exotic city of Mandalay and the beautiful region of Lake Inle.

Local travel in Myanmar will be by charter bus and plane, accompanied by official, licensed interpreters and guides. Hotel arrangements will all be 4 to 5 star accommodations with all meals included.

Myanmar Domestic Tour fees of \$1300.00 will include all domestic transportation, hotels, all meals, guide services, admission fees and taxes.(for single occupancy add +\$200.00).

International roundtrip airfare from Denver to Yangon is currently estimated at \$1400.00 (airfare prices subject to change) *Once the group itinerary has been established, participants are welcome to use their own mileage accounts to meet the group in Bangkok for the flight into Yangon. Reservations and deposit of \$1300.00 are due by April 30th. Myanmar requires a visa, and we will need at least two weeks for processing. (Visa application fees are applicable and non-refundable.) The balance will be due once the visas have been processed so that group airline reservations can be made. Participants must be 18 years of age and in good physical condition.
